## Teaching notes

This activity is designed for the AQA course HIS1N: Totalitarian regimes.

Students should be asked to divide the events into those which occurred in Fascist Italy, and those which occurred in Nazi Germany. They can then be arranged into date order using the date cards. Several date cards are provided for some years, where more than one of the events occurred. Answers are given below.

An interactive Magnet activity is available for subscribed members, and could be used to complete the activity as a whole class, or to check answers after completing the task on paper.

Students could take each event and write a sentence to explain its significance.
