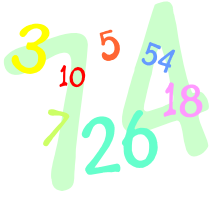


Task

Challenge question: How many seats had they gained since the last election?
95

4. Cities Hitler visited in seven days during the 'Führer over Germany' campaign.
20

Challenge question: What other tactics did the Nazis use in their election campaigns?
Answers could include: posters, pamphlets, rallies, disrupting communist meetings with violence, soup kitchens.

230

Challenge question: What proportion of the total seats in the Reichstag was this?
One third

6. Seats the KPD (Communist party) won in the November 1932 election.
100

Challenge question: Which groups most feared the Communist party in Germany?
The upper and middle classes, industrialists, anyone with savings

7. The number of people unemployed in Germany by the end of 1933.
6 million

Challenge question: Which Nazi slogan was aimed at people in this situation?
'Work and bread!'

8. The date in January 1933 that Hitler was made chancellor.
30

Challenge question: Who appointed him?
President Hindenburg

9. The number of Nazis in the cabinet formed in January 1933.
3

Challenge question: Why didn't Hitler like this?
He still could not pass laws without getting the agreement of others

10. The month in 1934 that Hitler made himself Führer (as a number).
8

Challenge question: What did he make the army do in this month?
Swear an oath of allegiance to him.
