

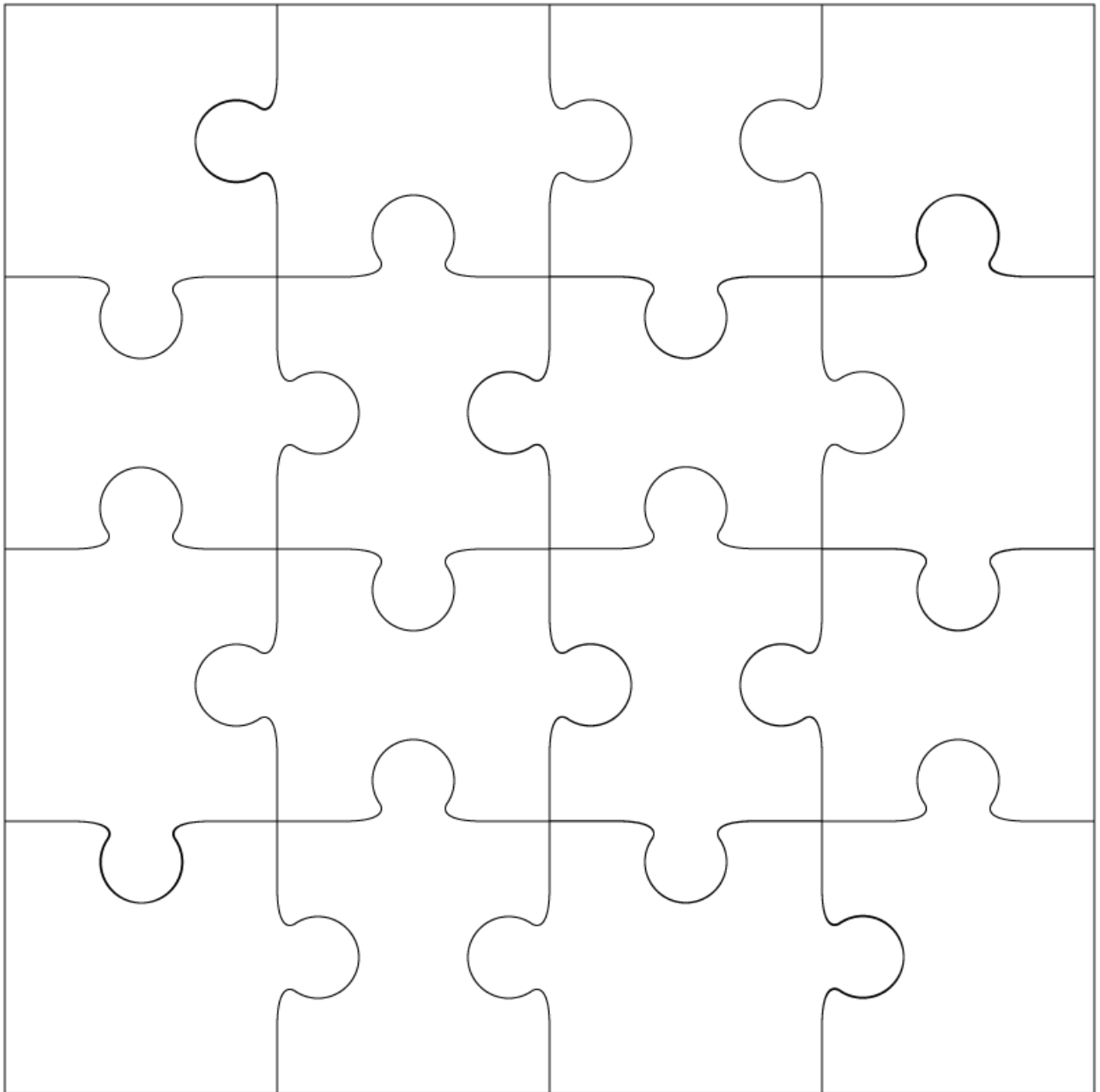
The purpose of this activity is to make links between events. You can think of everything you have learned as being like a big jigsaw puzzle – your task is now to put the pieces together!

- Fill in each piece of the jigsaw below with a key event from the Weimar years. You can use the ones on the cards here, or make up your own. You should think hard about the positioning of each event and use the corner pieces for the ideas that hold everything together. Each piece needs to link to the pieces next to it.

League of Nations	Rise of the Nazis
First World War	Treaty of Versailles
Occupation of the Ruhr	Hyperinflation
Stresemann	Munich Putsch
Locarno Pact	Dawes Plan
Kapp Putsch	Spartacist Uprising
Weimar Republic	Rise in Nationalist feeling
The Young Plan	'Stabbed in the back'

- When you are happy with your jigsaw you can cut out the pieces. Swap with the person next to you. When you have completed each other's jigsaws explain your own and note the similarities and differences between them.
- You can use this technique for revising any other topic.
