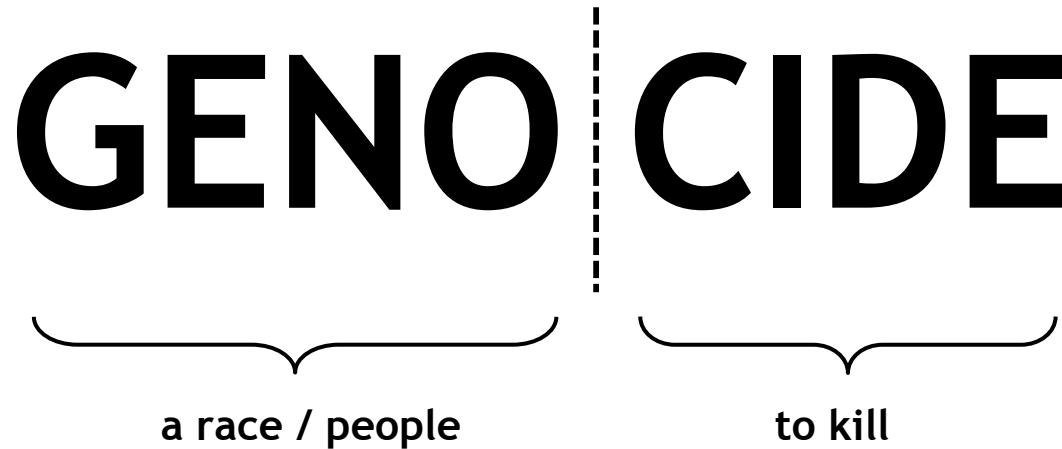


# History etymology

Origin: Greek - 'genos'

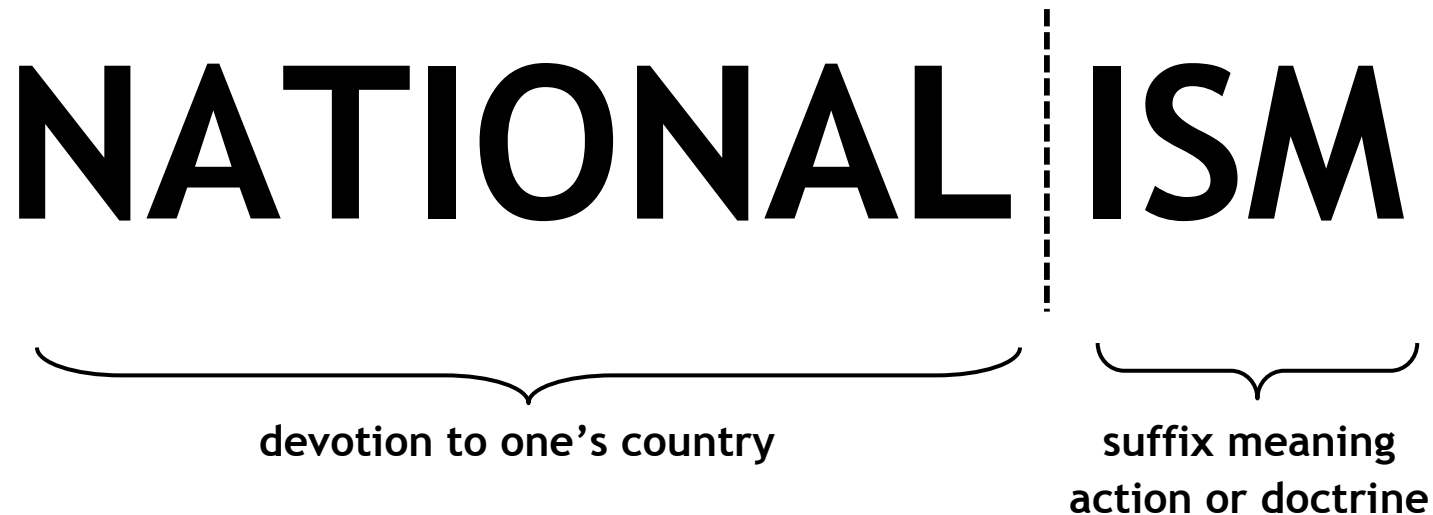


The term genocide is an official term used in international relations. Before this was established, Winston Churchill called it a 'crime with no name'. The word was not used before 1944.

Origin: Latin - 'significantem'

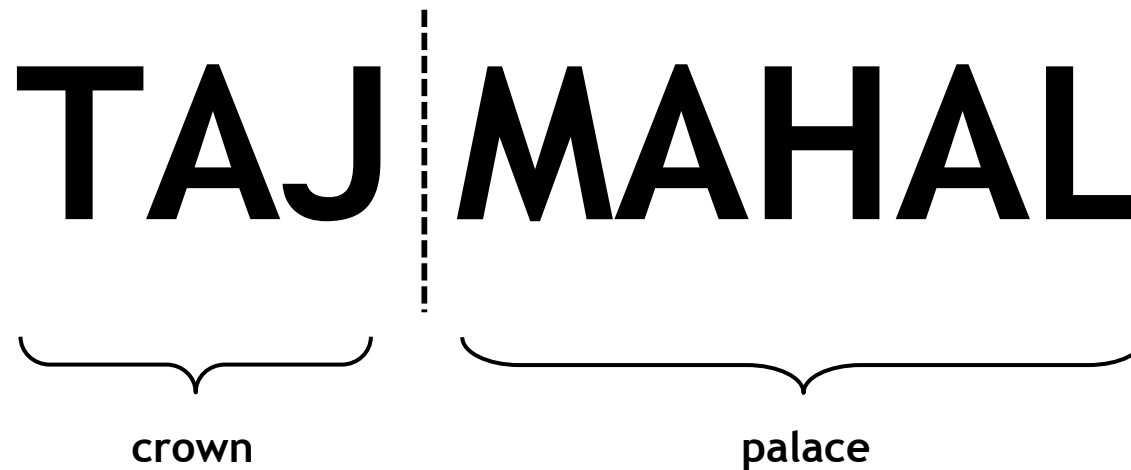

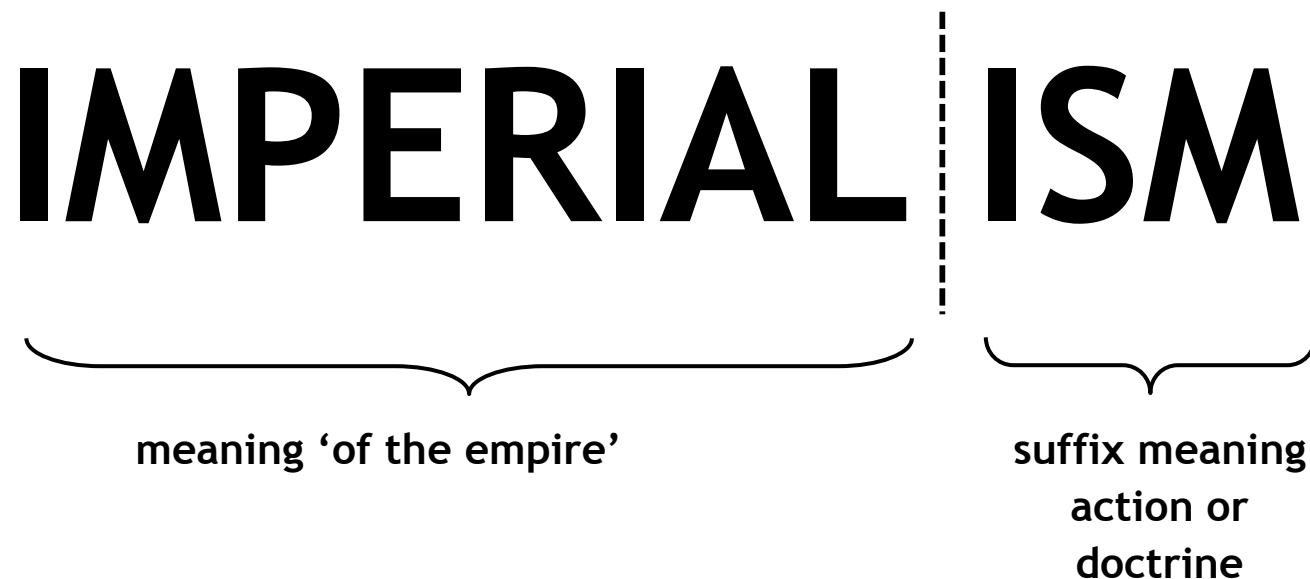

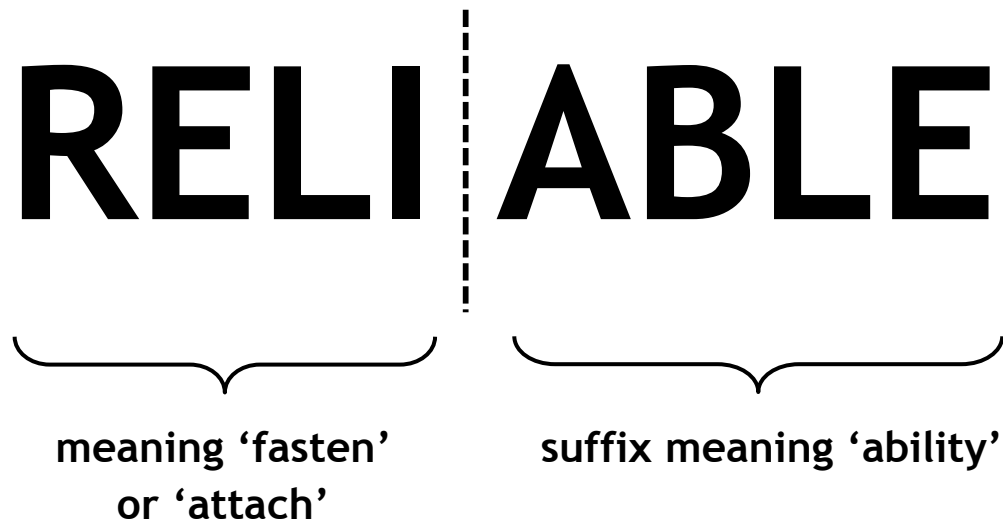
