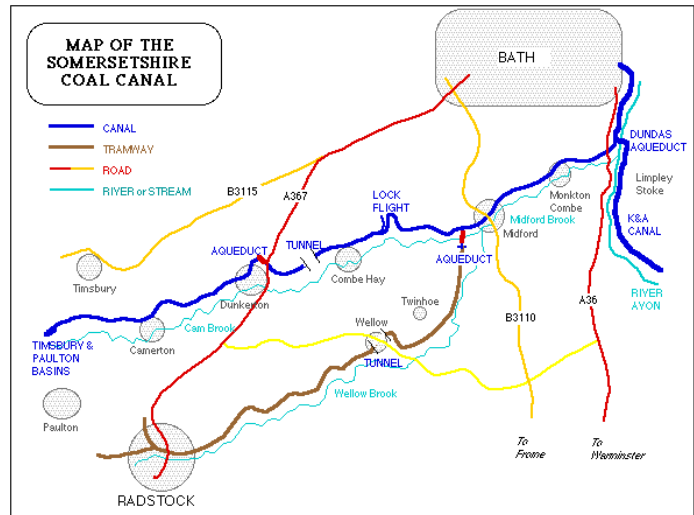


Somerset coal canal Sudoku

The Somerset Coal canal was built between 1794 and 1805.

The canal connected the Timsbury and Paulton basins to the Kennet and Avon Canal at Dundas aqueduct.

In 1904, the abandoned canal was sold to the Great Western Railway Company.
