

Teaching notes

Objective:

- This resource is for KS4 students, to revise 'Nazi life' or 'Road to war' in preparation for their GCSE exam.

How the activity works:

1. The answers to the quiz questions are put up on the board in a random order. (A PowerPoint slide to project is also available with this resource on Teachit History. Search '25719' on the site to find it. Alternatively you could print and distribute p.7 or p.8 of this document.)
2. Students are each given a copy of the blank bingo grid (p.2) and choose which answers to fill in the spaces, at random.
3. The teacher then reads the questions and students have to cross off any answers that they have. They can compete for a line and then full house.
